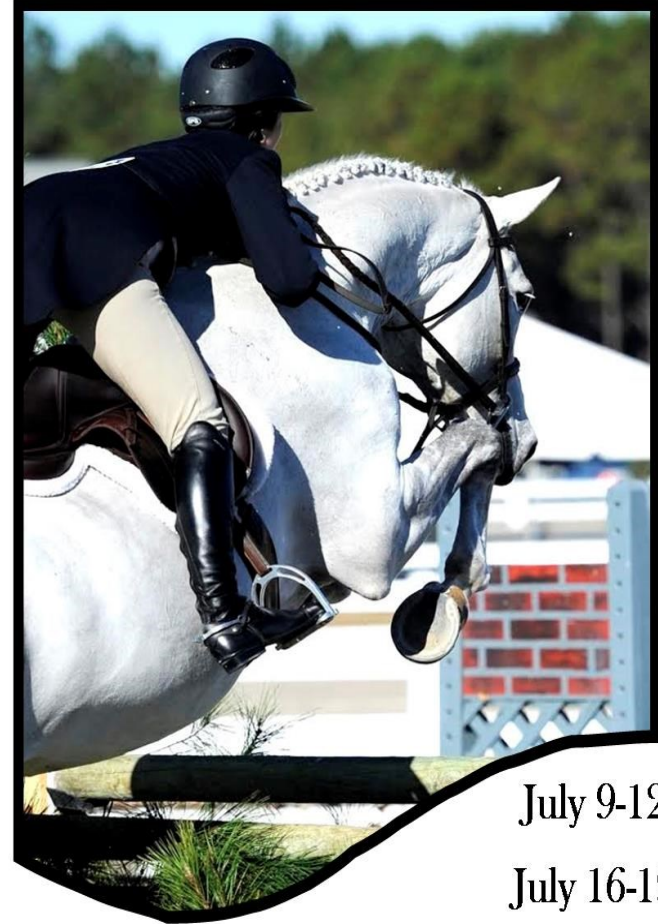

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Entries The closing date for entries for Pensacola is **Monday, June 29th, 2015. After that date ALL stall fees are nonrefundable.** Completed entries accompanied by check or credit card should be sent to address on entry blank. Checks are to be payable to Elite Show Jumping. No horse may participate in the event or be on the grounds without having a completed entry blank, including signatures acknowledging the agreement printed thereon. Horse show management is not responsible for entry errors due to incomplete or illegible entry forms. If one wants points to count toward end of the year award, the owner's, horse's, and rider's USEF member numbers must be on the entry form. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees incurred by them or their agents, even though payment may not be submitted with entry. Parent or legal guardians of minor exhibitors will not hold Elite Show Jumping, Inc., staff, or facilities responsible for any injury to such minor. No minor's entry will be accepted without the signature of a parent or legal guardian. Entry forms for each show must include horse's name, rider's name, all classes or divisions entered, ALL MANDATORY SIGNATURES, and Social Security or Federal ID numbers of owners. Current negative Coggins tests are required for admittance to the grounds. Entries received after the closing date of 6/29/15 will incur an additional fee of \$25.00 per horse. Refunds are given to entries with cancellation prior to the show, less a \$15.00 processing fee. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for returned checks. Upon notification, accounts will be given (5) five days to be paid in full. If not made agreeable in five days, sanctioning organizations will be notified for disciplinary repercussions. Additional fees such as a \$25.00/per day non-stabling fee or a \$50.00 non-showing fee will apply to those applicable. Both non-stabling horses and non-showing horses are expected to pay office and medic fees. Upon leaving an open signed check, exhibitors will receive their numbers. Any horse show bills not checked out at the conclusion of each show will be checked out by the horse show secretary. Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours. Please check your bills carefully. Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$8.00 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. (Total \$16.00 USEF Fee). Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Zone Support fee of \$2.00. **Credentials** ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDENTIALS (MEASUREMENT CARD OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATION) TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. Kindly send a photo copy of credentials with entry to facilitate processing. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Anyone not presenting valid membership credentials (USEF/USHJA) will be charged a \$30.00 non-refundable non-member fee per organization. Amateur exhibitors not able to present valid Amateur Credentials will be required to pay the \$30.00 annual Amateur Card fee. **Only a parent will be exempt from the Federation non-member fee if signing as coach for his/her minor child.**

Horse Registrations All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR091.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions in order to receive a number.

Motor Homes A limited number of motor homes and camper sites are available. Please send in RV reservation forms prior to mailing entries for camper reservations. \$250 per week.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Stabling and Bedding 300 10x10 permanent stalls with doors are ECC \$185 AWC \$200. There will be a discounted rate of \$155 ECE and \$175 AWC if paid in full by closing date. To receive the discounted rate of \$155 ECE and \$175 for horse and tack stall an entry blank for each week must be completed in full and payment

received prior to closing date of Nov 10th, 2014 for ECC, and Dec 29th for AWC. One horse/pony per stall. There will be no sharing of stalls. Shavings deliveries need to be made through the horse show office. There will be no Sunday deliveries. Trainers or agents need to check in with the horse show secretary Friday by **2:00p.m.** to verify shavings count and stall splits.

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid drivers license. The parent(s), guardian(s) or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be caused for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Protective Headgear Protective head gear, properly secured, must be worn **BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED, ANYWHERE, ANYTIME ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.** Headgear for **all riders** must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

Conduct Any act of discourtesy to a Judge, Show Official, or staff member on the part of any trainer, owner, rider, or groom will immediately disqualify any horse with which they are associated and all entry fees will be forfeited. No refunds will be made.

Schooling Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. Rings will be available for ticketed warm-up the day prior to the show. The rings will be available after the show for one hour each day and for limited schooling in the morning before the show. There will be no schooling over fences in the morning of the shows. Gate personnel have the authority to scratch riders who do not follow directions. Management may restrict schooling if conditions warrant.

Schooling Rings are off limits to horses not entered in show in the current week. All horses on grounds must have a current entry blank in the office and be entered in the show.

Poling and Off-sets Manual poling and the use of bamboo off-sets are prohibited for all horses competing. Any rider, trainer, groom, or other person involved with poling or off-setting will be subject to a \$500 fine.

Lunging Lunging will be restricted to designated areas. There will be no lunging in show rings or schooling rings.

Attire Jackets will be worn for hunter and equitation classes. Tucked-in polo shirts can be worn in the jumper ring. For classics and medals, formal attire is required. In extremely warm conditions, for the safety of our competitors, jackets will be waived.

Dogs All dogs must be on leashes in agreement with state and local laws. Unrestrained dogs are a safety hazard for exhibitors and their horses. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301. Dogs that are loose are subject to impound and a \$100 fine.

Electrical/Fire Regulations All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith". Please include this statement in future prize lists. Thank you.

Hunter Division National Rated

Parking Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in stable area. Those parked in unauthorized spot will be subject to fines and towing of vehicle at owner's expense.

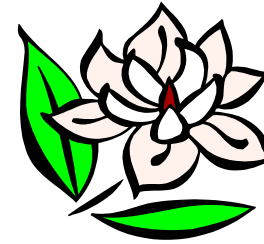

Adult Amateur Hunter:

Adult Amateur Hunter classes are for amateurs 18 years of age or older showing horses and/or ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. Adult Amateur Hunters are to be shown over fences at either 3' or 3'3". Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and any class where otherwise eligible. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible. Horses are not required to be jogged for soundness, but may be jogged at management's discretion. Zone Awards will be presented annually to the Adult Amateur Hunter 18-35 section and to the Adult Amateur Hunter 36 and over section. The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are less than three total in Children's Hunter section and if there are less than three total in the Adult Amateur section.

Children's Hunter:

Children's Hunter classes are for exhibitors under the age of 18 showing horses. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. The Children's Hunter section may be divided by age of rider or height of fences. The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony section when there are less than three entries in either section. Children's Hunters are to be shown over fences at either 3' or 3'3". Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class, but may not cross-enter into any Junior Hunter or Junior Jumper class at the same show. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible. Horses are not required to be jogged for soundness, but may be jogged at management's discretion. Zone Awards will be presented annually to the Children's Hunter 14 & Under section and to the Children's Hunter 15-17 section.

Children's Hunter Pony:

Children's Hunter Pony classes are for exhibitors under the age of 18 showing ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. Suitability (size) of pony to rider is of particular importance. The Small/Medium Children's Hunter Ponies are to show over fences at 2' and Large Children's Hunter Ponies are to show over fences at 2'6". The section may be divided at managements' discretion. The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony section when there are less than three entries in either section. Rider age restrictions as found in "Regular Pony" sections do not apply. Riders may show only one pony in either the 2' or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the "Regular" Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3". Exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers. Ponies exhibiting in Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible but the rider may not show the same pony in the regular pony section. Note: The pony may only be shown by one rider in the Children's Hunter Pony Classic and that rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic. Ponies are not required to be jogged for soundness, but may be jogged at management's discretion. Zone Awards will be presented annually to the Children's Hunter Pony Small/Medium section and to the Children's Hunter Pony Large section. The Children's Hunter Pony section may be combined with the Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections if there are less than 3 total in the Children's Hunter and Adult Amateur sections.
