Bill Russell was a horseman, a husband, a father, a Grandfather, a son, a brother, and a very giving man in life. It is our mission to carry on his giving tradition. Our hopes are to help horseman's families in their time of need, as our family was helped in ours.

### **About Bill Russell**

William Russell Jr. March 5th, 1945– May 4th, 2012
Bill was a High School football hero, with a full scholarship from a Division one college. He decided to join the Air Force and serve his country. After Vietnam, he came home to work in the horse industry, with his wife Mona. Upon his return he serviced as a Huntsman and professional whipper-in, helping to found some very popular hunts, still in operation today. He began privately training and managing shows, such as Ramble Wood and Belle Meade Annual Horse Show. He was the first manager to offer the 3 foot divisions, starting a new revolution of showing.

As a trainer in the 70s, he was one of the top trainers in the Southeast. He had Champions at Washington International Horse Show, multiple winners of the Palm Beach Grande Prixes and Champions of the Country, with horses such as Deck Commander, Southern Brooks, Catch on Fire, Turf Fire, Bargain Hunter, and Signal Point to name a few.

Bill and Mona, raised 4 children, who are all still in the horse industry. During this time he graduated from college on the Dean's list. He held his Race Horse trainer's license and headed up the Georgia Thoroughbred Owner's and Breeder's Association for many years. He helped found the Georgia Tech and Georgia State Equestrian teams and serviced on IHSA committees.

Those who knew him, knew you could call on him at any time and he would figure out a way to help or offer an encouraging word.

As his brother said, "I don't know what it was about him, but when he was standing at the end gate, you felt like you could do anything." He was life's greatest cheerleader to all.



**Membership Statement** 

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lessonprogram); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Entries The closing date for entries for BRM Foundation is Monday August 26, 2016. After that date ALL stall fees are nonrefundable. Completed entries accompanied by check or credit card should be sent to address on entry blank. Checks are to be payable to BRM Foundation. No horse may participate in the event or be on the grounds without having a completed entry blank, including signatures acknowledging the agreement printed thereon. Horse show management is not responsible for entry errors due to incomplete or illegible entry forms. If one wants points to count toward end of the year award, the owner's, horse's, and rider's USEF member numbers must be on the entry form. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for all horses and fees incurred by them or their agents, even though payment may not be submitted with entry. Parent or legal guardians of minor exhibitors will not hold BRM Foundation, staff, or facilities responsible for any injury to such minor. No minor's entry will be accepted without the signature of a parent or legal guardian. Entry forms for each show must include horse's name, rider's name, all classes or divisions entered, ALL MANDATORY SIGNATURES, and Social Security or Federal ID numbers of owners. Current negative Coggins tests are required for admittance to the grounds. Entries received after the closing date will incure an additional fee of \$50.00 per horse. Refunds are given to entries with cancellation prior to the show, less a \$150.00 processing fee. A \$30.00 fee will be charged for returned checks. Upon notification, accounts will be given (5) five days to be paid in full. If not made agreeable in five days, sanctioning organizations will be notified for disciplinary repercussions . Additional fees such as a \$25.00/perday non-stabling fee or a \$50.00 non-showing fee will apply to those applicable. Both non-stabling horses and non-showing horses are expected to pay office and medic fees. Upon leaving an open signed check, exhibitors will receive their numbers. Any horse show bills not checked out at the conclusion of each show will be checked out by the horse show secretary. Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours. Please check your bills carefully. Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$8.00 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. (Total \$16.00 USEF Fee). Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Zone Support fee of \$8.00. Credentials ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDEN-TIALS (MEASUREMENT CARD OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATION) TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. Kindly send a photo copy of credentials with entry to facilitate processing. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Anyone not presenting valid membership credentials (USEF/USHJA) will charged a \$30.00 non-refundable nonmember fee per organization. Only a parent will be exempt from the Federation non-member fee if signing as coach for his/her minor child.

<u>Horse Registrations</u> All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR091.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions in order to receive a number.

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

<u>Stabling and Bedding</u> 300 10x10 permanent stalls with doors are \$225. There will be a discounted rate of \$200 if paid in full by closing date. To receive the discounted rate of \$200 for horse and tack stall an entry blank for each week must be completed in full and payment *received prior* to closing date of August 26, 2016. One horse/pony per stall. There will be no sharing of stalls. Shavings deliveries need to be made through the horse show office. There will be no Sunday deliveries. Trainers or agents need to check in with the horse show secretary Friday by **2:00p.m.** to verify shavings count and stall splits.

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

<u>Protective Headgear</u> Protective head gear, properly secured, must be worn **BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED**, ANYWHERE, ANYTIME ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. Headgear for **all riders** must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

<u>Conduct</u> Any act of discourtesy to a Judge, Show Official, or staff member on the part of any trainer, owner, rider, or groom will immediately disqualify any horse with which they are associated and all entry fees will be forfeited. No refunds will be made.

Schooling Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. Rings will be available for ticketed warm-up the day prior to the show. The rings will be available after the show for one hour each day and for limited schooling in the morning before the show. There will be no schooling over fences in the morning of the shows. Gate personnel have the authority to scratch riders who do not follow directions. Management may restrict schooling if conditions warrant.

Schooling Rings are off limits to horses not entered in show in the current week. All horses on grounds must have a current entry blank in the office and be entered in the show.

<u>Poling and Off-sets</u> Manual poling and the use of bamboo off-sets are prohibited for all horses competing. Any rider, trainer, groom, or other person involved with poling or off-setting will be subject to a \$500 fine.

**Lunging** Lunging will be restricted to designated areas. There will be no lunging in show rings or schooling rings.

Attire Jackets will be worn for hunter and equitation classes. Tucked-in polo shirts can be worn in the jumper ring. For classics and medals, formal attire is required. In extremely warm conditions, for the safety of our competitors, jackets will be waived.

<u>Dogs</u> All dogs must be on leashes in agreement with state and local laws. Unrestrained dogs are a safety hazard for exhibitors and their horses. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301. Dogs that are loose are subject to impound and a \$100 fine.

**Electrical/Fire Regulations** All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION: To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION: To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Sections offered and requirements: Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and any class where otherwise eligible. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible. Fence height: 3'0" or 3'3" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted May be split into three sections: Adult Amateurs 18 – 35 Adult Amateurs 36 – 49 Adult Amateurs 50 and over. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in a section, that section must be combined with another. The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are less than three total in Children's Hunter section and if there are less than three total in the Adult Amateur section. When sections are combined and there are more than 16 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries. Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Adult Amateur Hunter 18-35 Adult Amateur 36-49 Adult Amateur 50 & over

ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER Sections offered and requirements: Low Adult Amateur Jumper High Adult Amateur Jumper. Competition Management may restrict cross entries between High and Low sections at the same competition if stated in the prize list. Horse and Rider Combination: Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m (3'9") at the same show. Low Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. High Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Amateur Owner Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m (3'11") and above, that offers prize money, at the same competition. High Adult Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. Fence Height: Low Adult Amateur Jumper 1.00m (3'3") to 1.05m (3'5") High Adult Amateur Jumper 3'6" or 1.10m (3'7") to 1.15m (3'9")

Combining/Dividing Sections: Children's sections may be divided by or combined with Adult Amateur Jumper sections, at management's digression, if so stated in the prize list. Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Low Adult Amateur Jumper High Adult Amateur Jumper

Fence Height: 3'0" or 3'3" with spreads not to exceed fence height Combinations will be permitted Combining/Dividing Sections: The Children's Hunter section may be divided by age of rider or height of fences. If the Children's Hunter section is offered divided by age it will be divided: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under and Children's Hunter Horse 15-17. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either age section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony, Children's Hunter Horse and/or Adult Amateur sections when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. Riders may show only one pony in either the 2'0" or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the Regular Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. 

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# Please Read

The is BRM Foundation dedicated to the health, welfare and safety of all exhibitors both equine and human. To protect our equine partners, we will be enforcing the following protocols at the BRM Horse Show this summer.

It is advised that all horses stabling on the show grounds arrive between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. If it is necessary to arrive at any other time you must check in with the night security officer.

- 1. A current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test is required.
- 2. A Health Certificate must be signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at the BRM Horse Show.
- 3. Vaccination Requirements (per the USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule [CHAPTER 8F Welfare of the Horse] Rule Changes Effective 12/1/15) At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary
- 4. Any horse on the show grounds with a fever of unknown origin or of suspicious origin must be reported to BRM Horse Show management and to the Show Veterinarian. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls will either be available on the grounds or at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.
- 5. Please take the time to review equine good hygiene practices. Please convey the importance of this to your equine caretakers for their daily routines.
